FIRST QUARTER HIGHLIGHTS

- **Fairhope**- Construction process began: new parking lot addition; interviewed and selected an architect and a general contractor for the construction of our gymnasium.
- **Daphne**- Construction process began: plans in place for new construction; interviewed and selected an architect and a general contractor.
- **Robertsdale**- Prepared for Easter Sunrise gathering at our newly purchased property, near Robertsdale High School. Our church building will be built on this property in the future.
- **Midtown**- '12x9' Initiative, to spread out growing crowds among 2 Sunday gatherings.
- **Thomasville**- After recently purchasing new property on 13 acres, renovations have begun inside our future church facilities, situated directly on the main highway in Thomasville.

Our brand new 3Circle Ministry Residency began in January, with our first round of residents enrolled. Throughout the year, residents will receive hands-on ministry experience coupled with biblically-based leadership training, with each resident focusing on one of five ministry tracks: general ministry, worship ministry, worship technologies, family ministry, or student ministry. COUNSELING



- HCC has been able to add \$4900 from the benevolence fund to supplement counseling fees in 2023.
- We have 4 licensed counselors and a pastor seeing clients up to 4 days a week. Additionally, our financial counselor has helped singles, couples, and widows with budgeting, insurance, and social security.
- We are partnering with an associate counselor in April to continue meeting the mental health needs of our church members, and Baldwin and Mobile counties.
- HCC has provided a total of 384 hours of counseling appointments.

- We have utilized 43 dental volunteers, with 300 hours of service.


MEDICAL





SHARING THE GOSPEL TRAINING






It is always a joy to gather together for Nights of Worship at our campuses! The first quarter of 2023 included events at our Daphne, Fairhope, and Midtown campuses.





God is moving in Honduras and through an amazing team of missionaries to impact their community in tangible ways, all so that people would come to know the name of Jesus.

Lisa came to faith through the Hope Center years ago, and immediately started serving through short term medical mission trips. After many short term trips, she felt God calling her to full time



missions overseas. She joined the Jungle Hospital in October 2022. She serves the local communities, and is a part of an 8 person medical team that operates a primary care clinic and labor and delivery.
